At the sole discretion of the Sauk Valley Online Steering Committee, we reserve the right to remove any materials posted on the Sauk Valley Online web server we deem inappropriate.

Sauk Valley Online will:

- Provide web-hosting services for free only for the above participant for the period of one year from this date. Continuance of this service remains at the discretion of the Sauk Valley Online Steering Committee.
- Allow the Participant to update the Participant's web site by allowing FTP (File Transfer Protocol) access to the Participant's directory and only that directory on the SVO server.
- Update the SVO web site at least monthly to ensure updated content and local links. Provide technical support in a limited capacity.

The Participant agrees to:

- Be responsible for authoring the Participant's web site (or employing the services of someone to author the web site)
- Update the page at least monthly
- Be responsible for any violation of security or safety of the SVO web server that occurs under the "webmaster" account name noted above.
- Release all legal responsibilities/liabilities for materials posted on the SVO web server.
- Place the SVO official logo and a link from the Participant's home page to the SVO home page.
- SVO does NOT provide: dialup access to the Internet, web page creation, maintenance of Participant's web site, and email accounts.

Not-for-profit organizations will be provided free disk space for their web page under the SVOnline domain name. SVOnline will provide all other organizations with a link to their web page.
